## 2. A brief scientific report of the meeting:

The number of sessions was 8. The subjects of the sessions covered ionotropic and metabotropic glutamate receptors, Glu/GABA/Gln in brain pathology; Glu/GABA/Gln metabolism; Glutaminases and Transporters. Each session consisted of at least 4 short (20-25 min) lectures given by the best scientists from all over the world. The speakers came from the USA, Great Britain, Belgium, Norway, Spain, Greece, Italy, Denmark. There were also a few good speakers from Poland. The last day of the conference was dedicated for young scientists, as they had the opportunity to present their results as posters, on as the oral presentations. The total amount of money granted was used for the accommodation of speakers and/or chairmen, and for the coffee breaks/lunches/welcome dinner and banquet for all the participants.
