Report of the RegPep2016

The RegPep2016 International Congress (see poster page 10) gathered in Rouen, from July 12th to 14th, 2016, 319 researchers from 46 different countries, working on biologically active peptides. The scientific program (see page 9) set up by 23 international experts (see page 6) included 3 plenary lectures, 20 Symposia with 100 oral presentations, 21 oral communications selected from the abstracts and 99 communications in the form of posters. Before the Congress, participants were able to attend on July 11th, 2016, a Symposium funded by the Institute for Research and Innovations in Biomedicine (IRIB) titled 'Neuropeptides, from Bench to Bedside: How to fight brain pathologies with Neuropeptides' and a Workshop organized by the platform of Proteomics PISSARO in partnership with Agilent and Nanotemper titled 'Quantification of peptides in biological samples'. In addition to science, participants enjoyed a tasting of wines and cheeses on Tuesday, July 12th, a visit of the museums of Rouen and a dinner gala on Wednesday, July 13th, a guided tour of Rouen and a firework over the Seine River on Thursday, July 14th. After the congress, around 50 people have continued their stay in Normandy by a visit on July 15th, 2016, of the cliffs of Etretat and the Palace of the Benedictine in Fécamp.

On the occasion of the RegPep2016, a public conference was given by Dr **Serge AUVIN** (IPSEN pharmaceutical laboratories) at the Town Hall of Rouen on the theme 'Peptides, a natural origin of innovative medicines for patients'. This conference filmed with the help of Science Action Normandy can now be found on the web site of the association by <u>clicking</u> here.

For his organization, the RegPep2016 received among others, the financial support of the Normandy Region, the Rouen Metropole, Inserm, University of Rouen, Normandy GEFLUC, the journal Frontiers and the International Society of Neurochemistry (ISN). A list of all the sponsors of the RegPep2016 is available on the Conference Web site. Our financial supports have among other things allowed to give free registration to our invited speakers and to distribute 11 awards to young researchers who came to present their work in Rouen. The next Congress of the RegPep will be held in Washington (USA) in September 2018 with the objective to continue to federate the community of researchers working on biologically active peptides.

We would like to thank the ISN for the important financial support it has provided us for the organization of this international congress in Rouen. This financial support of ISN was used to give free registration to the 5 speakers (i.e. Illana Gozes, Seiji Shioda, Maria Pennuto, Nese Tuncel and Dora Reglodi) of the ISN Symposium on 'Therapeutic potential of PACAP/VIP neuropeptide family and related peptides in neurodegenerative and neuropsychiatric diseases' (2250 \$, see page 5 and 6). It also contributed to pay 1 travel award to young investigators (750 \$).
