

Report of the 11th Annual Conference of Neuroscience Society of Nigeria to International Society of Neurochemistry (ISN)

The meeting was held from the 28th of November till 1st of December, 2013. The local organizing committee acknowledge with thanks the sum of \$5,000 from ISN which made a significant difference to the financial status of the conference.
