The **ISN Advanced School on New Approaches on Glial Cell Research** took place in the Hotel Campus of the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona, Bellaterra, Barcelona, Spain, on July 10-13, 2012

The school was part of the activities of the **Young Investigator Training Program** (YITP) of the **FENS Forum 2012** (Barcelona, July 14-18, 2012) and was organized in collaboration with the **Spanish Glial Network.**

The aim of the school was to enable graduate students and junior postdoctoral fellows to enhance their knowledge on the function of glial cells in health and disease. The program included faculty lectures on state-of-the-art methodological and conceptual approaches to study the role of glial cells in synaptic function, development and CNS disease. Students had the opportunity to present their research projects and discuss ideas with experts in the field.

The blog http://isngliaschool2012.wordpress.com was set up to post the school information, program and call for applications.

At the deadline 128 excellent applications had been received. The school organizing committee ranked students essentially on the basis of scientific merit. The final number of students attending the school was 38 (23 PhD candidates + 15 Post-docs). Students had 17 different nationalities and came from Europe, America and Asia-Pacific. All students had free accommodation and meals at the Hotel Campus. Additionally, twenty students received travel awards. All students had to present their work in a poster format. Additionally, eight students were selected for short oral presentations. See summary table below.

The composition of the ISN Advanced School Organizing Committee, the final program and list of lecturers and the student's abstracts can be found in the *Program and Abstracts* book attached.

We have to acknowledge the collaboration of the Spanish Glial Network in the organization of the Workshop Frontiers in Glial Research that took place during the last day of the school for which they obtained a grant from the Spanish Ministry of Economy and Science that greatly contributed to support student's living expenses and travel awards.
