Advice on the content of the Curriculum Vitae for applications by ISN Student and Postdoc Members for ISN Young Members Symposia, ISN Travel Awards and the ISN Advanced School

Prepare your CV as pdf file for uploading to our application system.
Your CV should not be longer than 2 pages.

Please do not miss to include in your short CV the following information (if applicable):

- Full name
- Date of birth
- Gender
- Current position and institution
- University education (with the years the degrees were obtained)
- Month and year of your PhD
- Employments/Appointments

- 5 keywords that describe your main research interests
- Month and year when you joined ISN
- Membership in ISN Sister Societies (APSN, ASN, ESN)
- All financial support that you have previously received by ISN
(list year, type of funding, amount of support received)

- Awards and honours that you have received
- Fellowships and research grants that you have received
(list funders and amount of financial support in US dollars)

- Number of your publications in international peer-reviewed journals
- Number of first and last authorships on those publications
- A list of up to 5 of your publications (names of all authors, year, title, journal, issue, pages)

Please be aware that the international Committee that will evaluate your application, including your CV, represent scientists from different countries and continents. Therefore, please explain thoroughly the parts that you believe are complex, and refrain from using any type of local or national abbreviations that may not be understood internationally.
